### Section 1

What feels comfortable to you about using the question(s) you mentioned?

What was the "question before the question" that Newman Cahill recommends using? Do you think that is a pretty good way to smooth the path?

Do you think questions as simple as, "Do you believe in Christmas? What do you believe about it?" could be effective transitions?

How do you feel about using a tragic news story like 9/11 or something more recent? Do you think that might be disrespectful or is it OK to do something like that?

We run across so many people every day who wear crosses around their neck or in other ways like tattoos. How does the author suggest capitalizing on those situations.

Could you say that the cross has radically rearranged your life?

## Section 4

Discuss some ways we could apply a few of these principles in the next 7 days?

One suggestion (if needed): Pick two of the 8 questions, write them down right now on an index card, put them in your wallet right beside your money as a reminder, and try to use one or both in the next 7 days, maybe multiple times. Next week share about your experiences.
